rather lonely without
Leonta. I'm used to
calling her up nearly every
night.

Everyone seems most
anxious for the eggs to
come - I think I should
start a chicken farm near
here & sell them for about
45¢ a dozen. The hens
probably couldn't lay enough
eggs.

I have the lesson for
League this Sun. evening.
but I guess it won't bother

me much.

May go horseback riding
Sun. P. M. with Erna, Lou,
& her sister, Diana. Erna's
parents are in Texas visiting
Art who is there in the
army. They have been down
there a week & Erna has
been alone. One of her girl friends
has been staying nights with her
tho' I guess.

It's getting about time
to say good night. I'm
ready to hit the hay. My arms
are weakening. I just washed
my hair & got it put up which
is really a job. I may get some
of it cut off in front & an end
curl.
